Lund University is one of the world's top 100 universities and the most popular choice for international students coming to Sweden. ## World class education

- Lund University is Sweden's top-ranked university and ranked 60th in the world<sup>1</sup>. A non-profit, public university founded in 1666 – it is one of the oldest and broadest universities in northern Europe.

## Cutting-edge research

- A member of the international research-intensive university Networks LERU and Universitas 21 (U21). Ultrasound, dialysis and the world's fastest growing technology, Bluetooth, are all examples of revolutionary discoveries that have their roots in research at Lund University.
- In addition, two of the world's leading materials research facilities are being built in Lund:
  - MAX IV Laboratory, opening in 2016, will be the world's foremost synchrotron radiation source and will put Sweden in a class of its own in materials and nano research.
  - The European Spallation Source (ESS) is a unique facility for materials research which will be responsible for future research breakthroughs in medicine, environmental science, climate, communication and transport (opening in 2019).

## Excellent value for money

- Low tuition fees compared to similarly ranked universities in other English-speaking countries.
- Low living costs compared to other English-speaking countries. You will need approximately €850 per month to cover your accommodation and other living expenses.

## An international environment

- English is spoken by 90% of the population, allowing students and visitors alike to have a unique European experience without language barriers.
- Lund University offers over 100 Master's degrees taught in English and there are 130 nationalities represented by students studying in Lund, making it a truly international city.

- Sweden is a safe, modern and eco-conscious country with a great global reputation and one of the world's highest living standards.
- Sweden is ranked second best country in the world at providing higher education<sup>2</sup>.

# Pre-Master's Preparation Programme

The Pre-Master's Preparation programme will enable you to improve your English while learning the study skills and research methods needed for Master's degree studies. Upon successful completion of the Pre-Master's Preparation Programme, you will be well-placed to continue onto your chosen Master's degree at Lund University.

The programme, to be taught in Lund, is designed for academically talented students, who are close to reaching the level of English language proficiency required for admission, and who meet all other entry requirements to selected Master's degree programmes at Lund University. ## What will I study?

You will study two compulsory units of a research project and personal and professional development, plus English language. You will also choose additional academic subject units, depending on your intended progression degree, and availability.

## How will I be assessed?

Each module will have an assessment schedule, which will be completed by the end of the appropriate term, and will include formative and summative assignments and other assessment tasks. Assessments will be designed to demonstrate learning across the individual modules of the programme and to allow you to experience a wide range of the assessment methods used in European postgraduate programmes.
