




ONCAMPUS Amsterdam & University Campus

ECONOMICS AND BUSINESS

We work with the University of Amsterdam Economics and Business, which consists of the Amsterdam Business School (ABS) and the Amsterdam School of Economics (ASE). Our pathways give access to 4 of their BSc programmes.

It is conveniently located in the heart of Amsterdam, offering you the opportunity to gain a world-class education in one of Europe's most vibrant and appealing cities.

On completion of the Foundation programme you are **guaranteed progression*** to English-taught Business and Economics degrees at the University of Amsterdam.

The Amsterdam Business School has the triple crown status which means that the Amsterdam Business School belongs to the top 1% of the business schools world wide. It is accredited by the Association of MBAs (AMBA), EQUIS and AACSB.

There is an honours programme available for excellent students, who are able to achieve an honours diploma in addition to the undergraduate degree.

Business Administration

For students who see themselves working for a multinational corporation, a start-up company, a consultancy or a business-facing government agency.

Business Administration covers all the functional elements of businesses and organisations. From finance, marketing, accounting and strategy to international management, business ethics, and innovation management, you will get to know each of them.

Subjects will be taught by qualified lecturers with ample experience in the field and you will learn cutting edge research results in the area of business administration. Economics & Business Economics

Econometrics and Operations Research

You will analyse economic reality using mathematical models, translating the results into economic policy. The labour market is crying out for Econometrists and operations research and management specialists.

Small class sizes create a strong sense of community. Mentoring and group study supports your development throughout the programme.

Actuarial Science

For students with a strong interest and skills in quantitative, mathematical and statistical matters.



LIVING IN AMSTERDAM

Full support is offered by the team at ONCAMPUS to assist you in finding suitable accommodation before you arrive.

UNIVERSITY ACCOMMODATION

ONCAMPUS offers university accommodation through the University of Amsterdam, and private accommodation through The Student Hotel. As in many other major European cities, the demand for reasonably priced private housing is high, so we recommend you book your accommodation as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.



The University of Amsterdam is well known for high-quality accommodation in convenient and secure locations.

The housing is spread throughout the city; rooms are located in all neighbourhoods and are 15-20 minutes away from University, on average. Rooms are allocated on a first come, first served basis.

All rooms have a bed and mattress, table or desk and chair, wardrobe, bookcase or bookshelves, curtains or venetian blinds and lighting. The kitchen is equipped with a fridge and small cooker(s). Pots, pans, rice cookers or kitchen utensils are not usually provided, but are sometimes left behind by former students. There are also many shops where these items can be purchased.

Rent for single rooms varies from approximately €400 to €650 a month; rent for shared accommodation is approximately €350 to €400 a month. This includes heating, lighting and fuel costs.

Travel costs from student accommodation to the University

Most students will use their bike to go to classes and this will save you transport costs. You can also take the metro or tram to the university and costs are approximately €3 per day, depending on where you live.

THE STUDENT HOTEL

The Student Hotel is privately owned, purpose-built student accommodation. The rooms are high quality and competitively priced for this type of accommodation.

The Student Hotel has two locations: one in the city centre, approximately 10 minutes from the university and one in Amsterdam West, 30 minutes from the university.

All rooms are fully furnished with an en-suite bathroom, shared or private kitchen, Wi-Fi and flat-screen television with international channels.

Rent varies from €650 to €930 a month depending on the type of room. Included in the rent is your own bike to use during your time studying in Amsterdam, use of the gym, study spaces, lounges and games area.

The Student Hotel has a reception with 24-hour security, laundry room and restaurant/bar with regular social/cultural events. Rooms at The Student Hotel can be viewed online; if you wish to book a room then please contact ONCAMPUS Amsterdam for more information on how to book your room.



- AAB across three academic subjects with an average of 70%
- IELTS 7.0 or equivalent, with no single element less than 7.0
- Essay assessment and interview
- Motivation letter and CV

*Guaranteed progression is subject to meeting the specified entry criteria.

Who is this programme designed for?

This programme is designed to prepare international students, who have completed senior secondary education, for entry to undergraduate studies at the University of Amsterdam. The UFP is set at NOF level 3, which is equivalent to A level standard in the UK.

How long will I study for?

This programme lasts one academic year (nine months). The year is divided into three terms of seven to nine teaching weeks and one reading week. You will undertake up to **26 hours** of classroom-based study per week.

What will I study?

This programme includes English and three academic subject modules. English will be integrated into the teaching of academic subjects, as well as being taught separately for those who need additional support to develop their English language ability.

There are two academic pathways to choose from and you will study the pathway most suited to your chosen progression degree.

Academic skills relevant to the specific subject area will be taught to fully prepare you for university study.

How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed at regular intervals throughout the programme to ensure you are making the progress required to successfully complete the programme. Full assessment of the programme will take place in the final term. Assessment methodologies are aligned to those that will be experienced in the university environment, and include project work, essays, presentations and unseen examinations.

What support will I receive?

You will be supported by a personal tutor and subject pathway leaders who will regularly check your progress.


Their research addresses real-life problems from the professional field in close collaboration with both academics and professionals working in the particular discipline.
