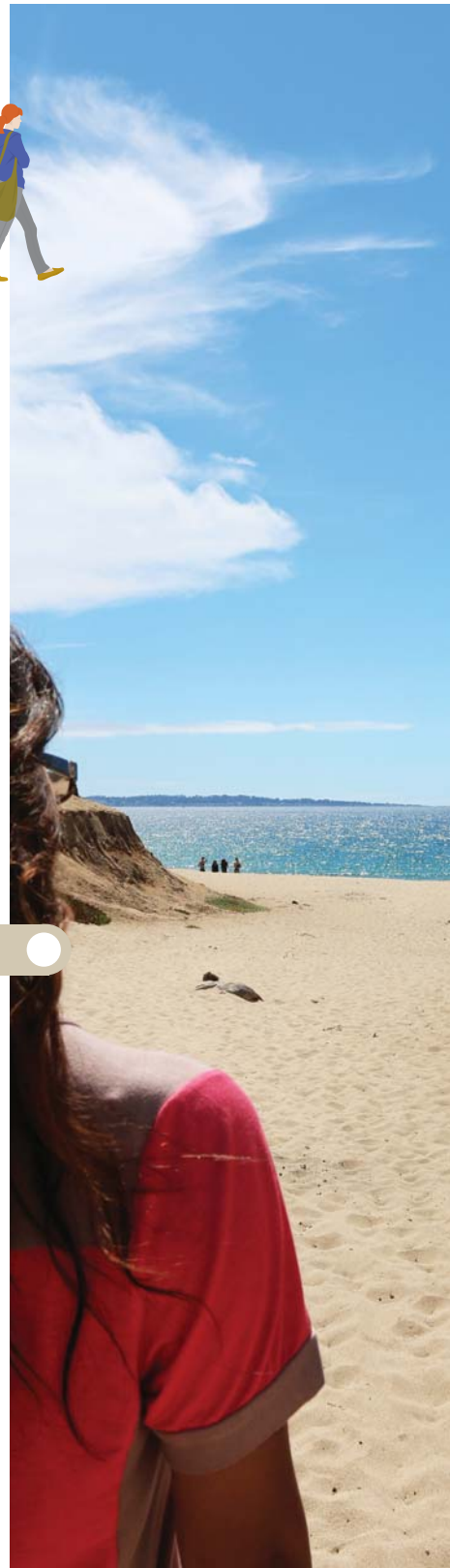

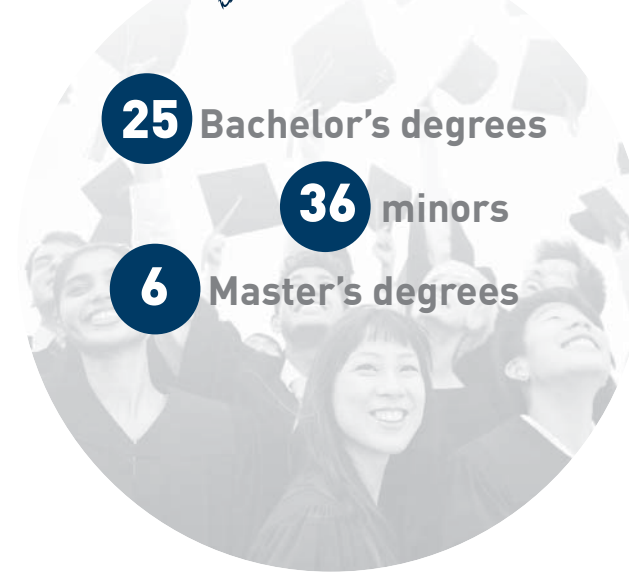

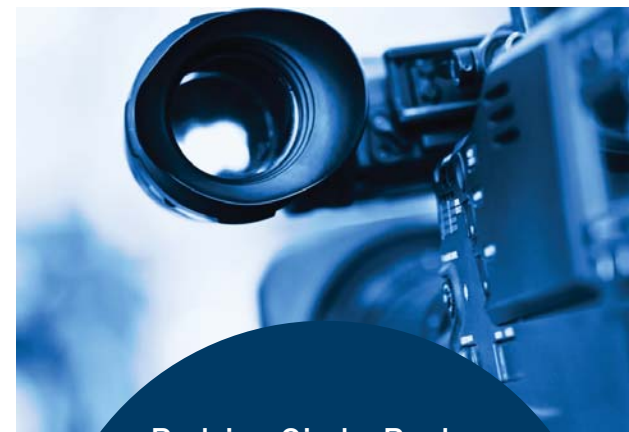

# MONTEREY BAY

Monterey Bay is centrally located on the coast of California, just two hours south of San Francisco, with Los Angeles and San Diego in easy reach. The bay itself, one of the world's largest marine-protected areas, is home to whales, deep sea anglerfish, and, of course, the CSUMB mascot, the sea otter. The CSUMB campus is near pristine beaches, redwood forests, mountain ranges, tide pools, fertile valleys, large expanses of farmland, and the Fort Ord National Monument.

The CSUMB campus sits halfway between the Monterey Peninsula, which features the coastal communities of Pacific Grove, Monterey (California's first capital), Seaside, Carmel, and the Salinas Valley, which is known as the "Salad Bowl of the World" for its abundant agricultural production.

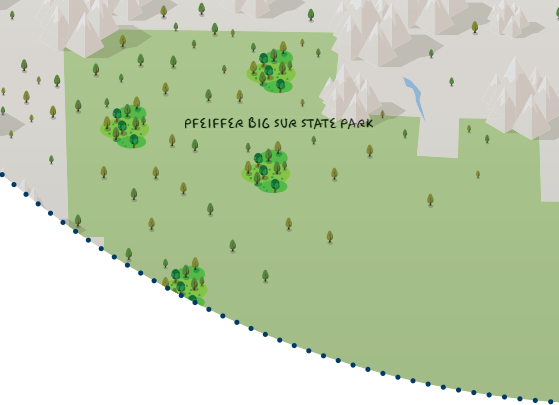

Otters play a very important role in the Monterey Bay ecosystem. They were once heavily hunted for their furs, which brought the otter population down to a dangerously low number of 50 in 1938. However, because of great conservation efforts, the Monterey Bay region now has more than 3,000 otters. You can usually see them hanging close to the shore when you visit the tourist areas, and you can definitely see them out in the water while doing water sports.

The Monterey Bay Aquarium has an active otter exhibit and a protective tide pool for wild otters to gather. Their live sea otter cam inspired Disney Pixar's recent hit film, *Finding Dory*, when creating their sea otter "cuddle party."

## \* HOUSING

Like most college freshmen, you will live in an on-campus residence hall (also called a dormitory, or "dorm" for short) with other male and female students right on CSUMB's campus. This is a mandatory part of **ONCAMPUS** Cal State Monterey Bay's program, because residence halls are an ideal place to make friends, socialize, and acclimate to college life in America.

### SAFETY

Students have secure access to dormitories with student ID card and key. Police officers from CSUMB are on duty 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The Nightwalk Service provides escorts between main campus locations 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Blue light phones are available across campus, should you need a direct line to the police. Students have access to the Center Director's emergency mobile number. The OTTERalert sends important campus information directly to your phone.

### Who is this program designed for?

This program is designed to prepare international students who have completed senior secondary education for entry to year 2 (sophomore year) of a U.S. undergraduate degree program.

### How long will I study for?

This program lasts one academic year. The year is divided into 2 semesters. You will take up to 29 hours of classroom-based study per week.

### What will I study?

This program includes supplemental support and academic subject modules. English will be integrated into the teaching of academic subjects, and will be taught separately if you need additional support to develop your English.

ONCAMPUS Cal State Monterey Bay has carefully selected its academic courses to ensure that you are working toward completing the general education requirements of CSUMB. This ensures you the maximum flexibility when choosing your major later in your studies. Our experienced staff are there to help and guide you through this process.

### How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed at regular intervals throughout the program to ensure you are making the progress required to successfully complete the program. Assessment methodologies are aligned to those you will experience in the University environment. They include project work, essays, presentations, and unseen examinations.

### Receive Offer

Within two working days, you will receive a response with either: (1) a conditional offer, (2) a request for more information, or (3) a notification that the application is under further review. Conditional offers will note any missing required documents.

- Send the completed Previous Study in the U.S. form and a copy of any previous or current visas and I-20 documents electronically to Admissions\*.
- Collect proof of funds as detailed in the Financial Declaration, with any additional required forms and send electronically to Admissions.
- Fulfill any remaining conditions noted on your conditional offer letter.
- Pay the registration fee (\$200) and the deposit (\$2,300).

\*These forms are required, and an acceptance letter will not be issued unless they are completed.

### Acceptance Letter and I-20

- Once you meet all conditions of acceptance, a draft Acceptance Letter will be issued within two working days.
- Review the draft Acceptance Letter to make sure all information is correct and accurate and confirm the shipping address and recipient to which the original of the I-20 document should be sent.
- Once any amendments to the Acceptance Letter have been sent to the CEG Admissions team, or the Acceptance Letter is confirmed accurate with them, the student will be emailed an electronic copy of the I-20 within one week, which will be followed by the original document in the mail.

### F-1 Student Visa Application

- Once you have received an electronic copy of your I-20, book a visa appointment at your local U.S. Embassy and collect all of the required documents.
- Follow the instructions from your local U.S. Embassy website to start your visa application.
- Students should ensure that they are prepared to answer questions relating to their chosen study program in the USA, their own educational background, their career intentions, and their reason(s) for choosing this particular course of study.

### Arrival at ONCAMPUS Cal State Monterey Bay

- A pre-arrival handbook, which includes important information for your course of study, and medical forms, will be sent along with the electronic copy of the I-20, and will help prepare students for their arrival in California. Students will receive a link to an online housing application in the Pre-Arrival Handbook.
- Students will also receive a housing form that must be completed and sent to the SRSO (see below).
- Students must provide arrival details to Admissions and should arrive by the day before the program start date.
- The first few days of the program are dedicated to an orientation delivered by both the **ONCAMPUS** Cal State Monterey Bay and CSUMB.





# Preparing for your student visa interview

Should your application be successful and you are admitted to our program, your next step will be to apply for a student visa. As part of your visa application process, you will likely have to attend an in-person visa interview. Below are some tips on how to prepare for this.

Please note: We cannot guarantee a successful outcome to your visa interview. These points are only meant to advise you on what you can expect during your visa interview.

**Do attend:** Failure to attend the interview may result in automatic refusal of your application.

**Do answer:** Always answer all questions fully and honestly.

**Do think:** Think in advance about your program, the documents you provided in your visa application, and your intended course of study. The Visa Official wants to know that you have given your course of study serious thought before choosing it.

**Do speak English:** The Visa Official will likely check your level of English, so always answer in English, not via an interpreter. Practice answers to potential questions, and be prepared for them.

**Do ask:** Ask for clarification if you do not understand a question, to make sure you are providing the information they want.

**Documents to bring:** Check the documents required by your specific embassy at: [www.usembassy.gov](http://www.usembassy.gov)

In general, students are asked to provide the following documentation:

- 1 Original I-20
- 2 Proof of payment of SEVIS fee
- 3 Completed DS-160 form (non-immigrant visa application)
- 4 Acceptance letter
- 5 Passport
- 6 Academic transcripts (with translations)
- 7 Financial evidence used for the I-20
- 8 Passport-sized photograph

Here are tips for some of the types of questions you may be asked:

**Question type:** General Information about you, your education, your choice to study in the U.S.

**Tip:** Show that you are a genuine student looking to further your education.

Make it clear that you plan to return to your home country after graduation. Give reasons for returning that are stronger than your reasons for remaining in the USA.

**Question type:** Intended Course: what you plan to study at ONCAMPUS Cal State Monterey Bay, course dates, and program details.

**Tip:** Become familiar with the information on our website and/or brochure.

Bring a brochure with you to show the visa official.

Explain why you want to attend your particular program for study. If the consulate official believes you want to remain in the USA after your program, you may not receive a visa.

Explain how studying in the USA relates to your future professional career in your home country.

**Question type:** Financial circumstances: Who will be paying for your course? What are the fees?

**Tip:** Bring all required financial documents and anything else you have that supports your financial status.

If you have been awarded a scholarship, bring a certificate or proof of your award.

**Question type:** Question type: Living in the U.S.: Where the school is located, and housing.

**Tip:** Bring your housing confirmation.

Learn about our location and clearly describe where the school is located within California.
