

Biometric Residence Permit (BRP) Collection

A Biometric Residence Permit (BRP) is a document issued to foreign nationals who have been granted a visa or immigration permission to live, study or work in the UK. Your BRP is an important document, which provides evidence of your immigration status in the UK.

When your overseas Student visa application is successful and if your course duration is longer than 6 months, you will be issued with a 90-day Entry Clearance Vignette in your passport or digital visa (applies to EEA nationals), which enables you to enter the UK. The BRP will cover the full duration of the course and needs to be collected upon your arrival in the UK either from the **ONCAMPUS** centre or Post Office.

When submitting a Student visa application – please input the ACL code from below in order for your BRP card to arrive in centre. Please be advised that the option of ACL code is not available at each of our UK **ONCAMPUS** locations. If the **ONCAMPUS** centre you are joining is not listed below – please include the postcode of your residence in the UK.
