

Applying for a visa to study at **ONCAMPUS Amsterdam**

Information for MVV students*

STEP 1

Meet all conditions of the programme and receive a Certificate of Enrolment from **ONCAMPUS Amsterdam**.

STEP 2

You will receive an "Immigration Procedure" email from Amsterdam University of Applied Sciences (AUAS) with details of the required documents you will need to send them. They require the signed original versions of these documents.

STEP 3

Fill out the relevant electronic forms listed in the email and email the required documents to AUAS:

- Copy of passport - 'identity details + signature' page and 'stamped' pages
- Antecedent certificate
- Declaration of intent to undergo a TB test
- Proof of financial means - € 950 x 12 months = € 11,400
- Proof that you have paid the full tuition fees. The tuition fees for the entire year will have to be transferred to **ONCAMPUS Amsterdam**.

Please note: Students with **these nationalities** will have to transfer at least €11.400 to AUAS in order to prove their ability to finance their studies. This will be refunded after their arrival in Amsterdam (after opening a Dutch bank account).

- You will need to pay €200 (cost of visa) directly to AUAS

STEP 4

AUAS will apply for an entry visa (MVV) (also called "provisional residence permit") and the student residence permit on your behalf. They will send your documents to the Dutch Immigration Department (the IND).

STEP 5

Once the embassy/consulate has permission from the IND, AUAS will contact you to tell you to contact your embassy/consulate.

STEP 6

Within 1 - 3 weeks the Embassy/ Consulate will tell you when it will be ready, you can go and collect the visa in your own country/ country of residency.

STEP 7

You use the MVV to enter the Netherlands. On arrival, AUAS will let you know when to collect your residence permit

Chinese students

If you are Chinese, but not Hong Kong, Macau or Taiwan Chinese, you need to obtain a NUFFIC certificate. You can apply for this as soon as you receive your Certificate of Enrolment from **ONCAMPUS**.

1. Apply for your certificate online at [the NUFFIC website](#)
2. Upload the following documentation:
 - a. IELTS or TOEFL
 - b. Transcripts
 - c. Copy of passport/ID card.
3. NUFFIC will send a copy of your certificate to AUAS.
4. The University will upload the required details to your online application.

POST STUDY WORK OPPORTUNITIES

After graduation from the University of Amsterdam, students have the opportunity to spend a period of up to twelve months in the Netherlands to find a job as a highly skilled migrant. The student will be able to extend their visa for 12 months. This is called the "Orientation Year". For more information, visit the [website](#)
