

## APPLYING FOR A RESIDENCE PERMIT TO STUDY AT ONCAMPUS LUND SWEDEN

## Information for Non-EU students\*

You must have applied for and been granted a residence permit before entering Sweden.

### STEP 1

Meet all conditions of the programme and receive a Certificate of Enrolment from ONCAMPUS.

### STEP 2

Pay the Registration Fee and Deposit. Other fees may apply, please contact Admissions for further details.

### STEP 3

Fill out an application for a residence permit at [www.migrationsverket.se](http://www.migrationsverket.se) uploading the required documentation.

- Passport pages that contain personal details (passport valid for at least three months)
- Admission decision or letter of acceptance
- Proof of health insurance
- Proof of ability to finance your study = 8,517 SEK x 10 months = 85,170 SEK

### STEP 4

Pay the application fee of 1,500 SEK

### STEP 5

The Swedish Migration Agency will process the application.

### STEP 6

Once you submit your application, you should go to the embassy or consulate-general as soon as possible to have your picture and fingerprints taken. This is so that you can be given a residence permit card. You will use this alongside proof of your residence permit to travel to Sweden.

### STEP 7

You will receive an email stating that a decision has been made on the residence permit. To obtain the decision you must contact the embassy or consulate-general. Take your passport with you when collecting the decision.

## POST-STUDY WORK RIGHTS

If you have a residence permit for studies at a university or other higher education institution in Sweden and have completed your studies, you can get a residence permit to seek employment or examine the possibilities of starting your own business here. You must apply for a residence permit while you are still in Sweden. This permit will be valid for up to 12 months.
