04. WESTFIELD SHOPPING CENTRE
London's newest shopping area and Europe's largest in-city shopping centre. The centre, between Kensington and Shepherd's Bush, contains 265 stores, a 16-screen multiplex cinema, gym and library.

06. TATE MODERN
Britain's national museum of international modern art. Each year, more than 5 million visitors visit the vast gallery to view some of the most famous (and bizarre) artworks in the world.

08. LONDON EYE
The tallest Ferris wheel in Europe, and the most popular paid tourist attraction in the United Kingdom, visited by over 3.5 million people annually.

03. ST PAULS CATHEDRAL
A Church of England cathedral and seat of the Bishop of London. The present church dating from the late 17th century was built to an English Baroque design of Sir Christopher Wren.

05. KEYWORTH CENTRE
As well as its facilities for conferences and small events this architectural landmark provides teaching space for the Faculty of Arts and Human Sciences.

07. BRICK LANE
Today, Brick Lane is the heart of the city's Bangladeshi-Sylheti community and is known to some as Banglatown. It is famous for its Sunday market and many fantastic curry houses.
