AAB from 3 A Levels (excluding General Studies and Key Skills).  
GCSE: English and Mathematics at grade B (or 6) or above.

### International Baccalaureate:

Pass Diploma and achieve 34 points, including 4 in standard level Maths and English.

### Other UK and international qualifications:

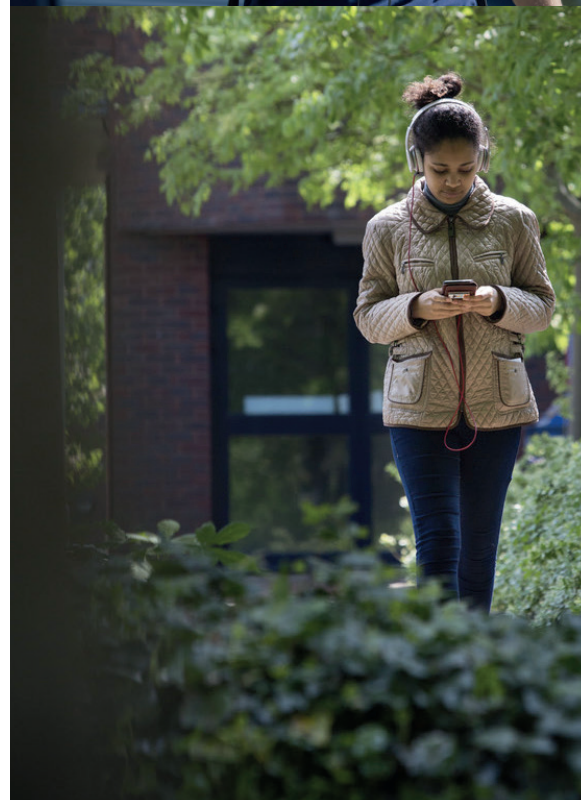
