OurDomain is right next to a subway and train station (only 1 minute walking), it is a privately owned and newly built student and young professional accommodation complex. All rooms are self-contained studio apartments and are very well priced.

Studios range in size from 23 to 34 square metres, and feature an en-suite bathroom with shower, wash basin and toilet.

The private kitchen is equipped with a ceramic cooktop, exhaust fan and fridge. Included is a comfortable bed (140x200cm), double wardrobe, cupboards with shelving, couch, table for dining / studying and 2 chairs, ceiling lights, curtains and carpeting.

Studios are 21.3m2 and feature a private kitchen and en-suite bathroom.


All shared kitchens are already furnished with two fridges, two ovens, two microwaves, a toaster, a dishwasher, and two freezers.

Private kitchens have a small fridge with freezer, an oven/microwave, and a kettle.

Rental prices vary from €1,043 to €1,399 (West location) per month, depending on the type of room.

Rooms

The housing locations are spread throughout the city. Some rooms are located in the city centre and others are further away (up to 40 minutes by public transport). Rooms are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Unfortunately, we cannot influence where in the city your room will be.

Rent for single rooms varies from approximately €450 to €850 a month, rent for shared accommodation is approximately €400 to €500 a month.

This includes heating, lighting, and fuel costs. Please note, space is limited.

UNIVERSITY-MANAGED ACCOMMODATION

The Amsterdam team will forward your information onto the UvA Housing team. In the first two weeks of June you will have to send in your application & pay the housing fee of EUR 395. Please make sure to keep an eye on your inbox, including your spam folder for this email.

Complete the steps to book your room. All payments will go to the provider directly. Most providers only accept Credit Card or Dutch Debit Card for accommodation payments.

Please note that **ON**CAMPUS will charge a one-off €395 Administrative fee to your **ON**CAMPUS statement of account for booking a private room with one of our partners. This fee will be added during your first term of study.



Getting to your accommodation

Amsterdam Schiphol Airport is situated approximately 20 km south-west of Amsterdam.

There are direct trains from the airport to Amsterdam Central Station run every 10 to 15 minutes between 6am and 12.30am and every hour during other times. The trip takes about 15 minutes and costs under €5. Fully regulated taxis are available 24/7 and cost about €50 into the city centre.

We strongly advise you to arrive during the week before induction so that you can move straight into your room.



Collecting your keys

If you have booked university-managed accommodation you will likely have to pick up your keys on location. More information will be sent to you by Housing company De Key or DUWO.

If you book a room at one of The Social Hub, you can collect your keys after 15.00 every day.

For a room at OurDomain, collection times are flexible. Please let them know your arrival time and date before you arrive in Amsterdam.
